I (Dene) have been given the task to help plan a gender reveal for one of our young adults and I'm so excited she has asked our home to be the place she wants to have it at. She had her baby shower here nearly 2 years ago. I have also been working on setting up the downstairs area in the Louis Bull Church with the baby gates being set up, and collecting toys off of facebook marketplace/thrift stores/donating ours we no longer use. I'm also excited to have found a koala diaper changing station for the church as well. With the population of young people in the church that we have, everything has been useful for Sunday services. I will be helping to set up more for the children, but until we get other renovations going downstairs I will hold off on doing more there. I am still wanting to prepare the downstairs area to have it become a drop in space for families during the week. I'm hoping to have Bible studies come out of it as well as its main role. My meetings with young adults have been consisting of helping with their paperwork for taxes, income support, or training. We just did a naloxone training session with a few others at our home. Many of our young people are seeing a rise in overdoses in the community. We want to help them prepare for how they can help as they navigate their community struggling with addiction.

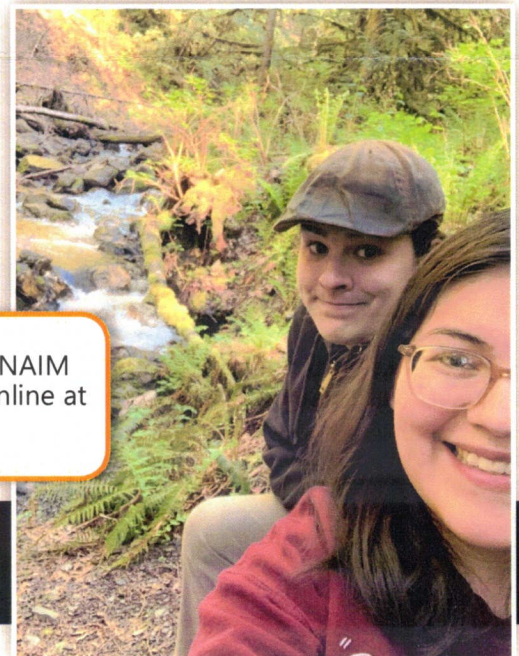
As we head into summer, here are prayer requests:
